Beacon Checker

The BCA Beacon Checker is an exciting new product that not only ensures safety, but promotes the use of avalanche transceivers. This compact and weatherproof box is mounted at backcountry access points, ski patrol headquarters, alpine huts and other points where transceivers are used. Tracker technology inside detects whether the closest user's beacon is transmitting. This is indicated with a green "O" or red "X". Includes a sensitivity control, dimmer, audible buzzer, and outputs for gate latches and other mechanical devices. Includes signage and complete installation manual. Great for promoting beacon use in your area!



Beacon Training Park

Backcountry Access Beacon Training Parks (BTPs) are training systems created to make it easier for recreationists and pros to practice with their transceivers. It features 8 permanently buried transmitters wired to a central control panel. To change the scenario, just flick the on/off switches on the control panel. Instead of digging holes and reburying beacons all day, you spend your valuable time actually practicing with your transceiver. Includes signage, setup and use instructions.
